

Guidelines/Agreement for Sound System Use During Games at SMC

TASA Minor Hockey will allow minor hockey teams to play music and call announcements during home games during the 2019/20 season, provided the following guidelines are followed:

- 1. Each team is permitted to have only one primary person associated with the team designated to play music/call announcements during games. If the designated person is expects to not be able to attend all games, they may also name one alternate.
- 2. The designated person must be a parent/legal guardian of a child on the team.
- 3. The designated person is ONLY permitted in the timekeeper box to play music/call announcements no contact with players/coaches/officials is permitted.
- 4. No other individual, other than the designated person, is permitted into the timekeeper box (this includes other team parents, friends, children, etc.).
- 5. If the designated person is unfamiliar with the sound system, he/she must learn how to use it during a time when games are not being played.
- 6. The team manager will be responsible for ensuring the guidelines are followed.

The above guidelines are set to ensure that timekeepers, who are paid officials during the game, are able to perform their duties without disruption. Failure to follow one or more of the above guidelines will result in the team losing permission to play music/announce for the remainder of the season.
